



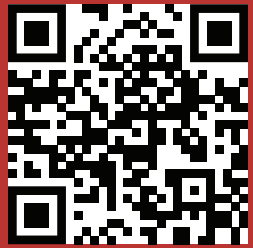

**THIS IS WHAT'S AT STAKE IF LAS VEGAS SANDS BUILDS THEIR CASINO:**

- Las Vegas Sands anticipates 23,000 visitors **daily**, leading to more gridlock on our congested roads.
- Casino Floor: 400,000 square feet, which is equivalent to the size of seven football fields.
- Entire footprint: Almost twice the size of MetLife Stadium, which will lead to more traffic in an already congested area with no mass transit.
- Two hotel towers: Each approx. 26 stories tall, twice the height of the Marriott.
- Restaurant seating for 3,670 people. This is equal to approx.18 restaurants. This will destroy our local business community.
- The Casino plans to extract a staggering 875,000 gallons of water daily from our, already, stressed aquifer.
- Projected gambling losses exceeding \$2 billion a year. This represents money that will not be spent locally at businesses and restaurants.
